THE COMPENSATION PACKAGE FOR THE STAFF OF THE FOUNDATION IS PAID BY THE LOWER DAUPHIN SCHOOL DISTRICT (LDSD). THE FOUNDATION PROVIDES SUPPORT ANNUALLY TO LDSD TO REIMBURSE THE SALARIES AS MUTUALLY AGREED UPON BY THE TWO PARTIES INVOLVED. SINCE THE COMPENSATION PACKAGE IS PAID DIRECTLY FROM THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, IT IS NOT REFLECTED IN THE ACCOMPANYING FINANCIAL STATEMENTS. THE SUPPORT FROM THE FOUNDATION TO LDSD IS PROPERLY REFLECTED IN THE STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES AS OPERATIONS EXPENSE.
FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2023, THE TOTAL COMPENSATION PACKAGE AMOUNTED TO \$12,862. THE FOUNDATION REIMBURSED THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE SALARIES PORTION OF THE COMPENSATION PACKAGE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,000 FOR THE SAME FISCAL YEAR.
